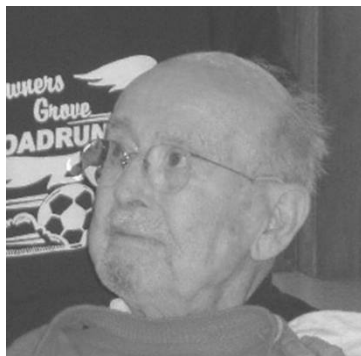

Dayton Cycling Club Board Meeting Highlights

The Dayton Cycling Club Board of Directors met Feb. 1, 2006, at the Vandalia Justice Center, 245 James Bohanan Drive, Vandalia, Ohio. In attendance were directors Ben VanWye, Anita Patten, Myrna Hayward, Brenda Taulbee, Michele Rizzardi, Walter Burton, Dale Williamson, Chris Brown, Barry Schroeder, Harv Kiesel and John Bargerhuff. Dwaine Wheeler attended briefly. Member Bob Tackett was also present.

President Ben VanWye called the meeting to order at 6:41 p.m.

Secretary Brenda Taulbee distributed the minutes from the Jan. 11 meeting for review. The words "see below" were added to the cover page to clarify that there was further discussion about the beginning site for the Clair Duckham birthday ride. Anita Patten moved to accept the amended minutes and Dale seconded. All approved.

Treasurer Michele Rizzardi distributed her report. She has received 48 registrations for the Feb. 18 banquet (last year's attendance was 95). After review, Barry moved to approve the report and Anita seconded. All approved.

Sheri Noer, membership director, was absent, but her written report was distributed. The current club membership is 686.

John Bargerhuff, the newsletter editor, asked for a volunteer to take

pictures at the awards banquet. The program from the banquet, which will be included in the March *Spoke 'N' Link*, will have the award winners listed, with the exception of the special awards to be announced that night.

Webmaster Harv Kiesel was not present, but he did e-mail Ben asking for additional information about the Clair Duckham ride to put on the Web site. Additional items for publicizing this ride were explored.

Touring Captain Walter Burton updated everyone about a recent series of e-mails, reiterating the following points made at the January 11th meeting: 1. Only the Clair Duckham birthday ride will be listed April 30th 2. Ride leaders should list regularly scheduled rides in the Spoke 'N' Link in order to allow the widest range of people the opportunity to participate. All present agreed that these points were the basis of our discussion at the Jan. 11 board meeting.

Wright Wride Director Kay Wert Minardi was not present, but Anita reported that Kay is working on having the ride originate at Carriage Hill MetroPark this year.

OLD BUSINESS

Anita reported that registration for the banquet is low. She is working on the preparation of a script and an agenda and will deliver both to Myrna

before the event. We do have a guaranteed minimum number of people required, according to the Crowne Plaza agreement.

NEW BUSINESS

Kay e-mailed everyone about the Ride of Silence to honor cyclists who have been killed or injured while cycling on public roadways. The ride this year is on May 17.

We participated last year, and she feels that we should consider doing it again. We published the ride in 2005 and had 17 riders show up. Walter volunteered for this responsibility.

Dale Williams would like to open up his Huffman Spring Classic volunteer pizza party this year to all Dayton Cycling Club volunteers, not just those volunteering for his event.

Ben was contacted by someone from the Five Rivers MetroParks regarding a grant for the establishment of a bicycle "hub" at Patterson Boulevard and Monument Avenue in downtown Dayton. The metroparks asked for input from the DCC board, but because of the deadline of the Monday prior to this meeting, Ben chose to write a letter in support of the project. No one objected to this action.

Dale motioned to adjourn and Walter seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:36 p.m. The next meeting will be at 6:30 p.m. March 8, again at the Vandalia Justice Center.

Clair Duckham

Ohio Governor Bob Taft has agreed to attend our April 30 celebration of Clair Duckham's 100th birthday. Taft's grandfather President William Howard Taft took office almost two years AFTER Clair was born on April 28, 1906. Bicycles still outnumbered motor cars on the streets of America at that time.

Governor Taft has joined us for four past birthday rides, and commented during the last one, "Clair is a great example of what cycling can do for the human body. He is an inspiration to all Ohioans."

When Duckham was born, two bicycle mechanics, bicycle makers, and bicycle racers, Orville and Wilbur Wright, were perfecting their flying techniques on Huffman Prairie near Dayton. They were still relatively unknown, and had yet to sell their first aeroplane.

Duckham himself has been a fixed-wing aircraft pilot since the 1920s. This winter, at age 99, Duckham learned to fly a helicopter, and was featured in the Chicago-area news when he took three Chicago television reporters up in the helicopter.

In addition to aviation, the

younger Duckham rode a motorcycle for fun. When he discovered the bicycle during his forties, it was love at first sight. He soon became a bicycle racer.

The 55-year-old Duckham in 1961 joined friend David Ashmun in asking Huffy Bicycle Corporation Chief Executive Officer Horace M. Huffman, Jr. to sponsor their attempt at a record crossing of the United States by tandem. Huffman was not interested in the record, but he was interested in creating a bicycling club. During that meeting, the three men created the framework for the Dayton Cycling Club. Starting as a small racing club, our Dayton Cycling Club is now the second largest club in the state of Ohio with 700 members!

Duckham also joined the Wheelmen, the national organization of collectors of vintage bicycles, accumulating a large collection of high wheelers, safeties, and related items.

Many Wheelmen will be riding the route with us on April 30. Following the historic cycling theme, I have requested the presence of the mobile Bicycle Museum in the Frisch's parking lot. This truck trailer includes 17 historic bicycles, tracing

the history of the bicycle from the Draisienne (1817 bicycle which had no pedals) to current bicycles.

Duckham's long-time wife Jaynelle passed away in 1999. Two years after her death, Duckham donated his vintage bicycles to the Bicycle Museum of America, sold his north Dayton house and all of the sports cars, and moved to be close to his daughter, Nancy Eberhardt and her family in the Chicago area.

Nancy said, "Mother supported him in his interests for all of those years. She also became interested in the high wheelers."

During the 1990s, we started celebrating each birthday with an annual ride from his home on the north side of Dayton to the Frisch's Big Boy Restaurant in Troy, where Duckham and his "Gray Wolves" cycling group often stopped for meals.

About 30 family members from across the country joined Duckham for his 99th birthday party in 2005. The group included daughter Nancy, son Dan from North Carolina, many grandchildren, and even great grandchildren. Nancy said, "The birthday is a family reunion every year."

Directions to Clair Duckham's Birthday Ride Starting Point

Clair Duckham's April 30th birthday ride will start at the south end of the Forest Park shopping center parking lot. This former shopping center is southeast of the corner of Main Street (SR 48) and Shoup Mill Road, (aka Needmore Rd. or Wright Brothers Parkway). Adventure Golf used to be open on Main Street in front of this parking lot. If you need an address for your favorite internet mapping tool, Sherer's Ice Cream store is just across the street at 4425 N. Main.

If you are arriving from I-70, exit at the Main St. exit in Englewood and drive south about four and a half miles. From I-75 take the Needmore Rd. exit and drive west about three and a half miles. Turn left on Main St. and the shopping center will be on the left, just south of the car dealer on the corner.

The ride will end at the Frische's restaurant, I-75 exit #74 (State Route 41) in Troy.

Where do you go when you ride on the bike paths? Many of the bikeway cyclists I know have a motto: "Eat To Ride & Ride To Eat." They bike to a restaurant in Xenia or Brookville, a burger wagon in Miamisburg, a hotdog stand in Kettering, etc. I am all for this type of cycling but our local trails lead to other interesting destinations as well.

The Creekside Trail is not too far from the Greene County Public Library in Beavercreek and the Little Miami Scenic trail is near the Greene County branch in Yellow Springs and the Clark County Library in Springfield.

The Clark County library, in particular is a beautiful, airy building

to visit, even if you are just catching your breath in the air conditioning. If you get a card and check out books you now have another ride scheduled to return them!

In Spring Valley you can visit the shooting range; just follow the sounds of gunfire. I admit I was intimidated when I first went there, but the "patrons" are a very interesting and diverse group.

I learned that the "Firearm Community" does not consist of a bunch of card-carrying NRA members: in fact, several people to whom I spoke disapproved of the way the NRA portrays them – people with huge collections of fully-functioning AK-47s by their front door, just waiting for a burglar to show up so they can shoot him.

A Department Of Wildlife officer is always on duty and everyone was concerned with both gun safety and your safety while you are there. They are as enthusiastic about pro-

moting their interest in a positive, fun way as cyclists are about riding. It is an interesting place to visit, especially for a bleeding heart liberal like me.

Of course, there are parks all over the place: Englewood; Caesar's Creek; Sycamore State Park and lots of others. These parks offer a perfect excuse to "cross train" by getting off the bike for a little while and doing some hiking. You can load up a trailer with a picnic lunch, too...oops, we're back to "riding to eat" again!

My favorite ride right now is downtown Dayton on the weekend. You can ride to Riverscape and then travel on nice, wide streets with very little traffic. The architecture and history of some of Dayton's buildings is interesting and fun to explore...if you get too curious about a particular site, you can always re-search it at the library!!

Better Ohio Bicycling Bill Passes Ohio House Votes

I am happy to report that our Better Ohio Bicycling Bill, House Bill 389, passed the Ohio House Transportation, Public Safety, and Homeland Security Committee by a unanimous vote of 10-0 in February and the full Ohio House on March 7.

Next, our bill goes to the Senate Highways and Transportation Committee, chaired by Senator Jeffrey Armbruster of North Ridgeville.

Please support HB 389 with a letter to your Ohio State Senator. Go to <http://www.legislature.state.oh.us/search.cfm> to find contact information.

In your letter to your state senator, please emphasize that HB 389: 1. More closely aligns Ohio cycling law with the Uniform Vehicle Code, 2. Has been approved by the Ohio Highway Patrol, ODOT, and the Ohio Dept. of Public Safety, 3. Is sponsored by Representative Arlene Setzer of Vandalia.

Bike Commuter Act

Congressman Earl Blumenauer of Oregon has reintroduced the Bicycle Commuter Act, H.R. 807. A companion bill has been introduced into the U.S. Senate.

The Bike Commuter Act would extend a tax deduction to employers who install showers, lockers, and other items to make bicycle commuting easier for their employees.

Please write to your Congressman, and encourage him to support the Bike Commuter Act!

While bike commuting to the League of American Bicyclists Summit in Washington early in March, I had the pleasure of parking my bike in a bicycle locker room created for Environmental Protection Agency employees who commute to the Reagan building. John Foote Qualifies for Solo RAAM

DCC member John Foote has qualified for the Race Across AMerica (RAAM) solo division on the basis of a 24 hour ride he completed in Sebring Fl. Aiming for the qualifying goal of 425 miles, John rode 437 miles and finished with 40 minutes to spare.

John said that he spent only 6 minutes off the bike, during which he performed 2 three minute clothing changes. He used a total liquid nutrition diet during the race, handed off by his crew.

The RAAM starts in San Diego and finishes in Atlantic City after passing through Troy, Ohio. John's qualification is good for 3 years. He

has not decided how soon he will participate.

John rode his new Bacchetta Ti Aero recumbent which he purchased after seeing one in Calvin's Challenge last May. He hadn't ridden for twenty years after a series of back surgeries, the most recent of which was early last year.

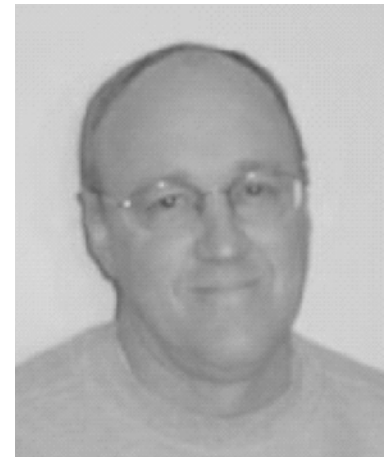

or for accompanying riders unfamiliar with the route.

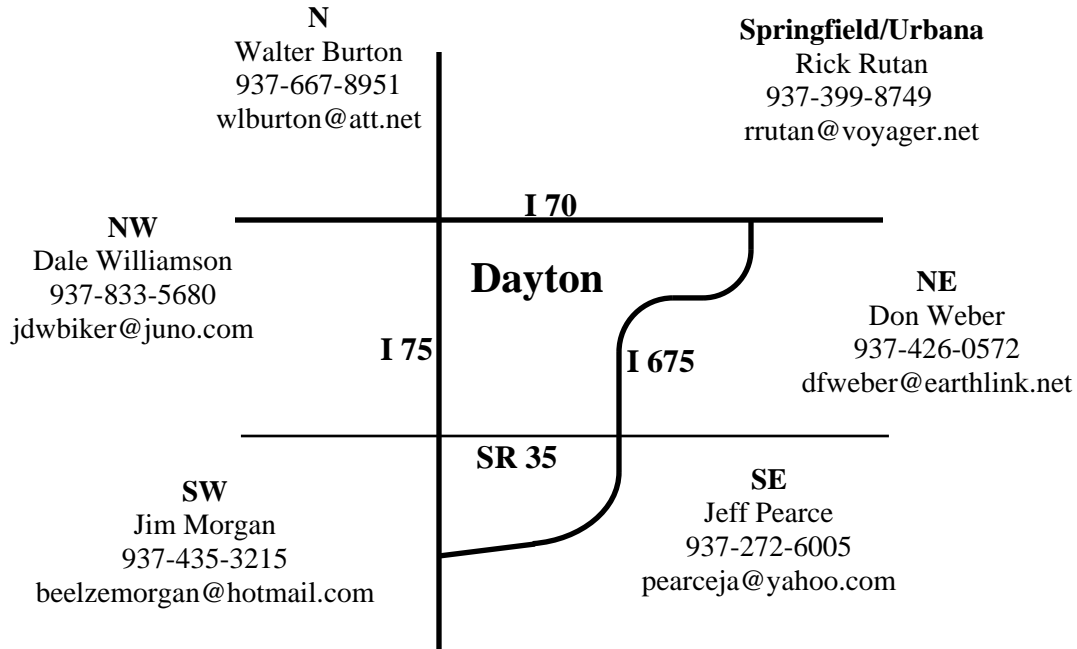
