We need nominations from ride leaders and other individuals for Most Improved Rider, Rookie of the Year, Ride Leader of the Year and anything else you think merits recognition. If you know of people who were ill or injured enough that they had to stop bicycling, but since have returned to riding, please let us know so we can give them Courage awards.

Directors of events should submit the names of all of their volunteers so those people can qualify for their half-price banquet discount and receive a plaque or bar.

It is up to individuals to report indoor mileage recorded on trainers or rollers during January, February and December 2006. Send this information to Patten and Hayward by Jan. 20.

In addition, it is up to individuals to see that their final 2006 mileage totals are in to the bikeway, commuter and touring mileage compilers by Jan. 5. Those people's names and contact information are available elsewhere in this newsletter.

We like to recognize children who have tallied 100 miles or more, but our database doesn't distinguish between adults and children. Parents of children younger than 18 should contact Patten and Hayward by Jan. 20. Any miles the kids pedal, whether on their own bikes or on the back of a tandem or trail-a-bike, qualify.

Board Meeting Highlights

The Dayton Cycling Club Board of Directors met Wednesday, Nov. 1, 2006, at the Vandalia Justice Center, 245 James Bohanan Drive, Vandalia, Ohio. In attendance were board members John Bargerhuff, Chris Brown, Myrna Hayward, Harv Kiesel, Anita Patten, Sally Pinnell, Brenda Taulbee, Ben VanWye, Kay Wert Minardi, Tom Wilson and Dwaine Wheeler. Club members Beckey Douglas, Bob Pinnell and Chuck Smith also attended.

President Ben VanWye called the meeting to order at 6:32.

Outgoing Secretary Brenda Taulbee provided the minutes of the Oct. 4 meeting for review. The board accepted the minutes with no changes.

Incoming Secretary Kay Wert Minardi told the directors she hopes to tape the meetings in the future to help her keep track of the goings-on.

In the absence of Treasurer Michele Rizzardi, John Bargerhuff filled in. He reminded the board that the December business meeting, which will largely deal with approving a 2007 budget, will be Dec. 13 at Rizzardi's house. The meeting also includes a holiday potluck dinner. Bargerhuff distributed the Financial Report concluding Oct. 30. The board accepted the report with no objections or abstentions.

Chuck Smith, DCC Commuter Committee chairman, reported that DCC co-founder Clair Duckham was hospitalized with a virus. He said the 100-year-old Duckham was on the mend.

Finally, Smith solicited submissions for the Ohio Bicycle Federation's 2007 Bicycle Events Calendar. Smith said that if the club wants to place a color quarter-page ad as it has done for the past several years, the cost will be \$560, and the ad deadline is Jan. 27. The board agreed that such an ad is a good idea, and Wert Minardi volunteered to design it.

Past President Anita Patten told the incoming board members that if they have any questions about their duties, there are job descriptions on the DCC home page under the By-laws link. She also reported that Michigan and Wisconsin, where she spent extended time this fall, have great biking.

Vice President Myrna Hayward told the board that DCC invitationals are a great bargain, even for day-of-ride registrants. She said she was surprised that the Cincinnati Cycle Club's Ghost Rider Ramble cost \$25 on the day of the ride and didn't include as much as DCC invitationals.

Membership Director Sally Pinnell reported that eight new members had joined the club since the October business meeting and 19 memberships had expired. She said this was pretty good, considering the time of year. As of Oct. 30, the membership stood at 299 adult, 316 family, 1 junior, and 11 honorary members, for a total of 627 members.

Newsletter Editor John Bargerhuff told the board that the Bikewise bicycle shop in Oxford had bought a year's worth of half-page ads. He



asked Wert Minardi to send him an invoice template so he could bill advertisers, and she promised to do so ASAP.

Webmaster Harv Kiesel reported that he added a link to "today's rides" by the weather links on the DCC home page.

Bikeways Director Chris Brown said he had helped Boy Scouts visiting from Louisville, KY, navigate 50 miles of Dayton-area bikeways. The Scouts were working on their cycling merit badges, and they and their troop leaders greatly enjoyed themselves. Brown hopes to offer this service to Scouts in the future.

Incoming Touring Captain Tom Wilson said he would like to appoint a couple of people in each touring area to call new members to invite them to rides. He feels that this would help new members get acquainted with the DCC and might lead to more new members riding club rides.

Wilson also announced that he would like to initiate a one week tour from Pittsburgh to Washington, D.C., largely on bikeways.

Patten stated that we need to recruit a new Calvin's Challenge director for 2008 and beyond. She reiterated that the DCC has built a national reputation with John and Ann McKinley's directorship and Barry Schroeder's and Kathy Williams' close assistance, and it would be a

shame to give that up just because they are retiring.

Wert Minardi said she would contact the McKinleys and ask them to write up an invitation for an apprentice director for 2007 who could train for the following years. This invitation would be published in the Spoke 'N' Link as well as on the DCC website. Sally Pinnell asked Wert Minardi to remind the McKinleys that their DCC membership has expired.

Incoming Wright Wride Director Dwaine Wheeler had nothing to report on the 2007 tour. As outgoing social director, he reported that plans for the Feb. 17 DCC Banquet are going well. Patten is handling the awards, except for the commuter awards, which Smith has volunteered to coordinate.

In old business, VanWye reported that he enjoyed Five Rivers Outdoors' GearFest. The stunt bicyclists were particularly impressive.

In a discussion of the future business meeting schedule, the 2007 board decided to keep the meetings on the first Wednesday of the month, except July 4. The July meeting will be on July 11. The location also will be kept the same.

In new business, new Clothing Committee Chairwoman Beckey Douglas introduced herself. Sally Pinnell said she would meet with Douglas after the meeting to go over the transition of duties.

A brief discussion of the 2007 budget was held. All directors are to submit their budget requirements to Rizzardi in time for her to set up a draft budget before the Dec. 13 meet-

ing. Member Bob Pinnell pointed out that 2006 budgeted membership income will not cover newsletter expenses, and the board needs to consider this in its 2007 budget deliberations. Possible fixes were discussed, such as raising membership dues (rejected at this time) and distributing only e-mail newsletters to those who request it. No obvious fix resulted from the discussion, but the directors took this problem seriously and promised to consider it before the budget meeting in December.

As all business was concluded, Wheeler moved to adjourn, and Bargerhuff seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:43 p.m.

These minutes were approved at the Dec. 13th DCC Board Meeting.

DCC/CCC Commuters Pass Million Mile Mark!

The two largest Ohio cycling clubs have combined forces during the last twelve years to log a million miles which may otherwise have been driven by motor vehicle! This joint effort has prevented the release of an estimated 100 tons of pollutants into the air of southwestern Ohio!

When I started writing this column in 1993, one of our top DCC commuters was Carl Bishop. When Carl moved to Cincinnati in 1994, I proposed that we start an interclub bicycle commuting competition for the betterment of the air in southwestern Ohio.

The DCC and CCC jointly purchased the Dayton Cycling Club/ Cin-

cinnati Cycle Club Commuter Challenge Cup (DC-8) and launched our competition. Each year, we engrave a small plaque and attach it to the side of the trophy, recording the miles for each club. We always feature our DC-8 trophy during our DCC banquets. In early December, I brought the trophy to Cincinnati for our second CCC banquet.

The accompanying chart shows the commuting miles for both clubs over the years. As you can see from the chart, both clubs have been successful in improving the air in our area.

Since then, Don Burrell of the Ohio/Kentucky/Indiana Regional Council of Governments has spelled Carl as the CCC Commuting Direc-

tor, but Carl continues to commute by bike, as does his son Ben.

To make this year memorable, plan memorable rides. This year is a great year for the ride you've always dreamed about.

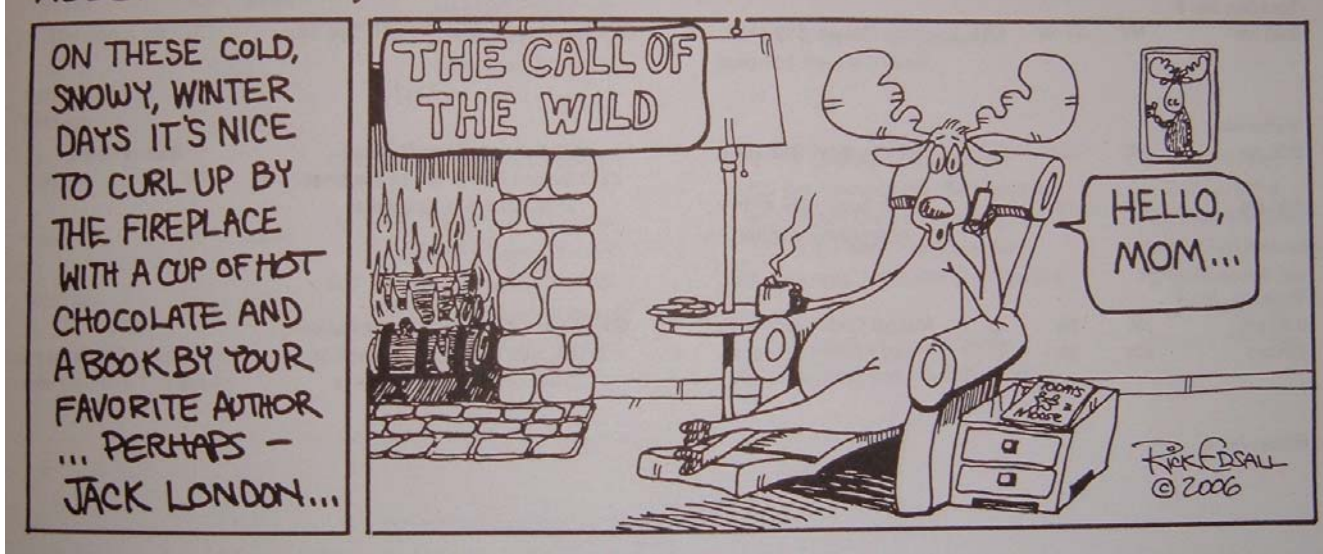
CSI Team is organizing

GOBA 2007 stays on our side of Ohio



Columbus Outdoor Pursuits in November announced that its 19th Great Ohio Bicycle Adventure will start and end in Celina.

GOBAville will open Saturday, June 16, at the Mercer County Fairgrounds. The opening activities will include the annual bike parade and costume contest.

The ride begins on Father's Day, June 17, when participants will ride to Van Wert. On Monday, the route meanders from Van Wert to Wapakoneta. Tuesday will be a layover day in "Wapak," with a 52-mile optional loop for those who must ride.

From Wapak, GOBA riders will go to Troy for another two-day stay. Thursday's optional loops will be 50 and 105 miles. On Friday, riders will go from Troy to Versailles, and the final day will be the return ride to Celina.

Columbus Outdoor Pursuits estimates the week's mileage at a minimum of 265 to a maximum of 425.

GOBA registration costs \$170 for adults (ages 16 and over), \$160 for adult COP members, \$85 for children 6 to 15 years old, and free for children 5 and under. Children under 2 are not allowed to ride a bike or be towed on GOBA. Registration deadline is May 16 or whenever the 3,000 spaces are filled, whichever comes first.
