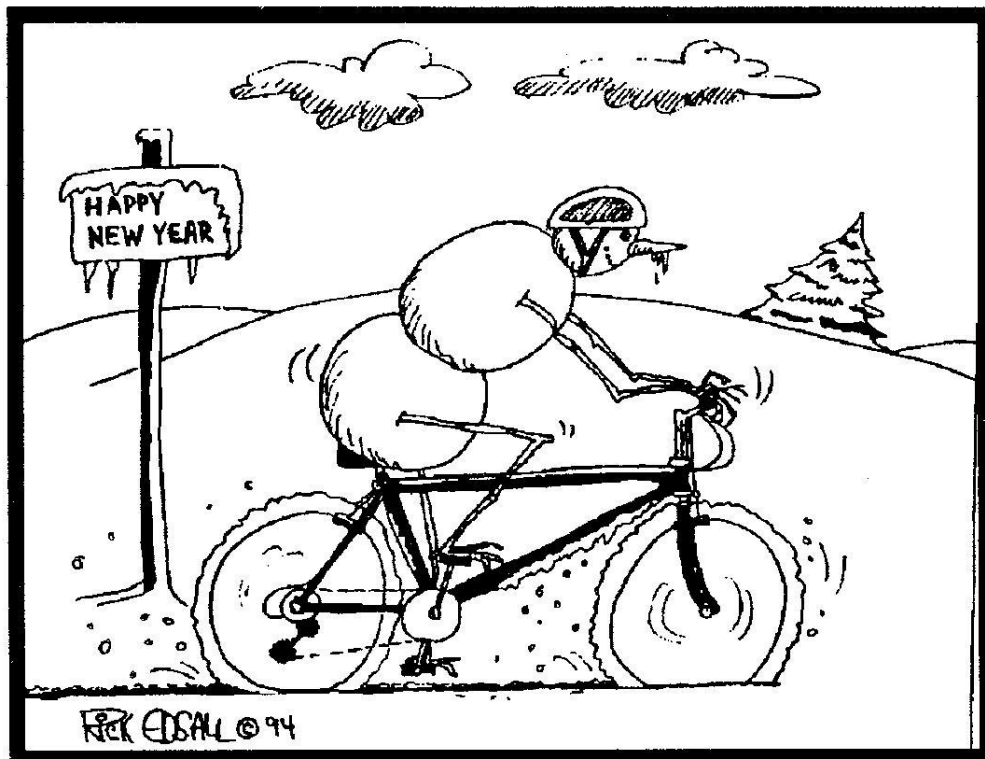

The 2 November DCC Board Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Newly elected Board members were introduced as follows:

Chuck Smith, outgoing Vice President, reported on the progress of Ohio House Bill 389 concerning uniformity of bicycle laws throughout Ohio. Chuck also encouraged DCC members to purchase Ohio's "Share the Road" license plates. Over seven hundred of the available one thousand plates have already been sold.

Plans for Clair Duckham's 100th Birthday Party were discussed. Chuck reports that Clair is in much better shape than last year and looking forward to riding with us on his birthday. The Troy Frisch's is prepared for a larger crowd this year. The board agreed that March 30th would be a good target date for final party logistics. Sheri volunteered to work on getting a proposal for T-shirts for this event.

Outgoing President Anita Patten reported that the date for the DCC Awards Banquet is February 18, 2005.

Minutes from the two previous Board meetings were reviewed. Kay moved to accept and Chris seconded. All approved.

Treasurer Michelle Rizzardi's Treasurer's report was reviewed and approved.

Claire Lea gave the membership report for new Membership Director Sheri Noer: total DCC membership is just over 700. Sheri expressed her sincere appreciation for the support and training that Claire is so generously providing her in this new position.

Bikeways Director Chris Brown passed out information on an Underground Railroad bicycle tour that is a combined effort of Brown County, Adventure Cycling Association, the University of Pittsburg. Chris also discussed new bike route signage recently installed in Beaver Creek.

Outgoing Webmaster Rob Pretzinger reported that all November updates have been added to the web site. Harv Kisel is becoming acquainted with his new DCC web site duties. Content was briefly discussed and past web site practices were reviewed. It was agreed that postings requested by for-profit groups would not be included on our web site.

Calvin's Challenge Representative Barry Schroeder reported that the 2006 event is scheduled for May 6th. Huffman Spring Classic Director Dale Williams reported that the logos for this Spring's Classic will be ready by next month. The route has been fine-tuned for a quicker return to Brookville and we can expect a new starting point this year.

The group was reminded that the Ohio Bicycle Events Calendar needs listings by December for our club's tours.

Wright Wride Director Kay Wert Minardi distributed t-shirts for the volunteers that helped with the event this year. The possibility that the Rotary Club may want to move the 2006 event to September was discussed. The Board generally agreed that we would prefer to keep the Wright Wride in August and that the DCC didn't want to risk losing the history or identity of this ride despite the numerous advantages of teaming up with the Rotary Club.

Kay is working closely with the new Newsletter Editor, John Bargerhuff, on the January/February issue. Our new President commented that the "Spoke & Link" was how he found out about the club, and what a great job Kay and Mark have been doing on it.

Claire Lea brought up the need to see more ads in the Newsletter, both local (besides bike shops) and national. Obtaining the support of big advertisers would be a real plus. Spoke 'N' Link editors agreed to conduct a survey of bike club newsletter rates and report back to the Board.

The Board agreed to explore new options for a regular meeting place in 2006. We will still have the January meeting at Choices, but members were asked to bring recommendations for other places where we could have meetings. We need seating for twenty people.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45.

Commuters Set New 12- Month Record in Only 10 Months

DCC commuters logged more miles during the first 10 months of 2005 than in any year since I started keeping track of club commuting miles in 1993!

The 61,596 miles logged through October surpassed our 12-month record of 61,474 set in 2001. We easily topped the 51,987 miles logged last year. The very strong 4,861 miles logged in November bring us to 67,399 miles, within striking range of 70,000 miles!

Bicycling to work, school, appointments, shopping, meetings, and other events permitted us to get 20 miles per bowl of oatmeal while motorists were paying dearly. We smiled as we pedaled around service stations advertising gasoline for sale at \$3+ per gallon.

Large Bike Tours at Risk

The Colorado State Patrol on Nov. 28th published a decision to limit bicycle rides in the state to 2,500 riders, effectively immediately. Because of the immediate public outcry, the ban has been postponed for one year.

In a letter to the state patrol, League of American Bicyclists Executive Director Andy Clarke said, "States around the country... have found safe and effective ways to host cyclists in the thousands, understanding that encouraging a healthy lifestyle and fun means of transportation is worth the extra work that large rides may entail."

The Denver Post has reported that the Lance Armstrong Foundation, which was planning a LiveStrong ride in Colorado next summer, is making contingency plans to move the ride to another state should the state patrol not overturn its cap on bike events.

Bikeways and Beyond

By this time you may be aware of the new “Miami Valley Recreational Trails Map,” published by the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission. This map shows all the trails in Miami, Clark, Montgomery and Greene Counties and how they’re interconnected. It shows the entire Little Miami Scenic Trail as well as details of downtown Dayton, Xenia, Springfield and Piqua. And it is printed on a tear-resistant, waterproof, recyclable synthetic “paper.”

We are fortunate to have such a beautiful, extensive trails system but these paths can also be dangerous: in the past I have written about game hunters near Urbana shooting across the trails; newspapers have reported joggers being accosted on occasion; and, near the end of November, a cyclist seemingly lost control of his bicycle and was found in the Great Miami River just south of Helena Street.

The best advice I can give you is, whenever possible, to use the “Buddy System,” along with carrying a cell phone. I know there are times when it’s nice to just be out by yourself and in fact I often ride alone. But using the “buddy system” can minimize the chance of being in an unpleasant situation. This can be especially important if you have any medical conditions, such as diabetes or heart disease, which could incapacitate you – merely carrying a cell phone may not be enough if consciousness is lost.

If you often ride the same routes, get to

know the people you see regularly. Riverscape, Xenia Station and other places along the trails have regular maintenance people with whom you can get to know. If you run into trouble you may be able to seek them out for help.

Our paths are here to be enjoyed. Please take responsibility for ensuring your health and safety while you’re out there.

The Great Ohio Bicycle Adventure is returning to the Miami Valley in 2006. Columbus Outdoor Pursuits' 18th weeklong annual tour will start June 18 at the Greene County Fairgrounds in Xenia and return there June 24.

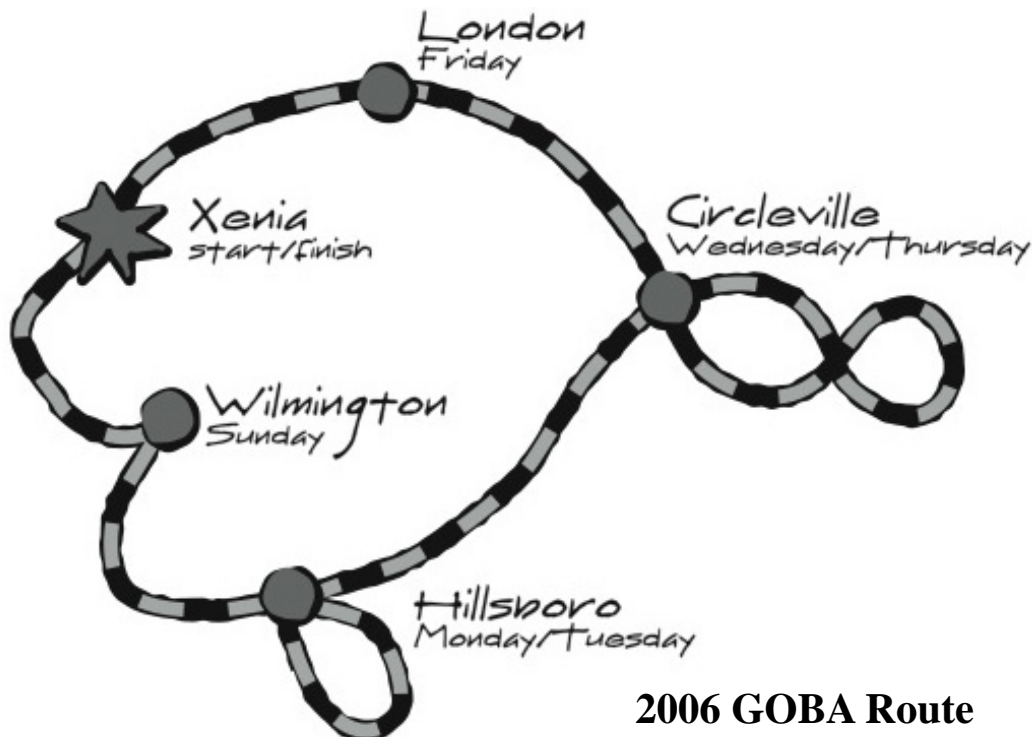
GOBA 2006 will be composed of five days of cycling 45 to 60 miles from town to town and two days of optional loops. Estimated mileage will be 265 to 400 miles, and the terrain will range from gently rolling to hilly.

The 3,000 cyclists will gather June 17 at the fairgrounds. Opening festivities will include a bicycle parade and costume contest, plus evening entertainment. The circular tour begins the next day, with the follow-

ing route:

- Sunday: Xenia to Wilmington
- Monday: Wilmington to Hillsboro
- Tuesday: Hillsboro layover w/ options
- Wednesday: Hillsboro to Circleville
- Thursday: Circleville layover w/ options
- Friday: Circleville to London
- Saturday: London to Xenia.

GOBA registration includes tent camping and luggage transport, with riders paying additional for food, other lodging, optional side trips and some activities along the way. The registration fee has increased for the first time in three years, to \$170 for adults 16 and over, \$160 for Colum-
