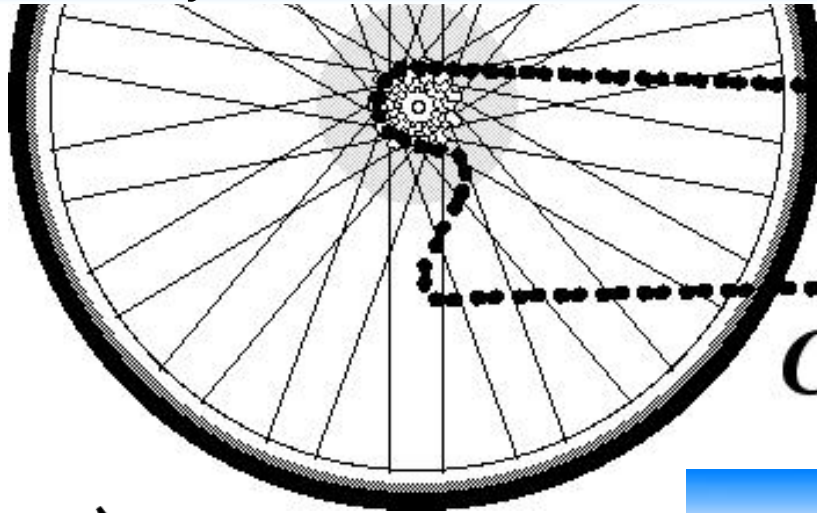

The club ride and mileage lists have been moved solely to daytoncyclingclub.org. You will be able to find more up-to-date ride offerings and mileage totals there than you can in an eight-times-yearly newsletter.

To find the ride list, choose the "Daily Rides" button on the left side of the home page. Then choose the month in which you want to find a ride. You also can access the touring mileage list from this page.

To find your mileage, choose the "Mileage" button on the left side of the home page, then choose

the current year for the type of mileage you wish to review. The most recent totals will pop up.

No doubt there will be more changes to come, especially since the DCC Board of Directors wants to reduce membership dues by \$5 at the Feb. 6 business meeting. As the DCC bylaws require, we would like your input — pro or con — to this discussion. If there is little or no opposition from the membership, we will approve the reduction.

This likely change in dues makes it **essential** that each member use a current membership application form when renewing. Please, make life easier on yourself and your membership team by using a form from the DCC website or the April 2013 *Spoke 'N' Link*. You will therefore send a check written for the correct amount, and we won't have to spend extra money on postage to issue refunds of overpayments.

DCC helps charity bike shop

At the Dec. 12 business meeting, the Dayton Cycling Club Board of Directors voted unanimously to donate \$1,000 to The Bike Shoppe at the Life Enrichment Center in Dayton, which was burglarized three times within a few weeks in the fall.

Shop doors and windows were broken and power tools worth nearly \$2,000 and 12 new bikes stolen. Thieves also cut batteries from the agency's trucks.

In 2012 alone, volunteers at The Bike Shoppe gave 353 bicycles to needy children in Dayton and repaired another 44. DCC member Bob Pinnell frequently volunteers at the shop.

The DCC board approved the donation for the replacement of tools to assemble and repair bicycles. After notification of the vote by DCC Vice President Chuck Smith, the DCC on Dec. 15 received the following message from shop manager Lacy Sorrell:

How wonderful, I am so thankful and pleased! This is an amazing Christmas gift as well as proof of the fabulous cycling community we have here in Dayton.

We will continue to grow and build to help make biking a stronger force. Thank you so much, Chuck Smith and the Dayton Cycling Club.

Meeting Minutes

Nov. 7, 2012

The Dayton Cycling Club Board of Directors met at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 7, 2012, at the Vandalia Justice Center, 245 James Bohanan Drive. In attendance were directors Ed Witte, Brenda Taulbee, Chuck Smith, Michele Rizzardi, Chris Brown, Harv Kiesel, Donna Powell, Kay Wert Minardi, Kathi Witte and Bud Bell.

President Ed Witte called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Secretary Donna Powell presented the minutes from the September and October business meetings for the board's review. Kiesel moved to accept the September minutes with the clarification of PayPal's fees, which are 2.2 percent plus 30 cents per transaction. Smith seconded this motion, and the minutes from the September meeting were approved as amended. The October minutes were amended with the addition of the statement that the club membership would be notified of any potential change in dues before a change is presented to the board for a vote. Smith moved to approve the October minutes as amended. Kiesel seconded the motion, and the board unanimously accepted the minutes.

Treasurer Michele Rizzardi distributed the financial report for October, noting that the financials did not yet reflect \$5,000 deposited to the general fund from the estate of James Perry. Rizzardi also said the club had not been reimbursed for insurance costs related to the Mum Festival Bike Tour. Ed Witte will follow up with the organizer. Smith moved to

accept the financial report for October. Wert Minardi seconded the motion, and the report was accepted without opposition.

Ed Witte announced the results of the DCC election and said those results have been posted to the DCC website. It was noted that Chuck Smith will serve as vice president while also retaining his advocacy role in 2013. The membership director and Huffman Spring Classic director positions are vacant.

Ed Witte suggested that the DCC sponsor a program to distribute helmets and/or blinking bicycle lights, and discussion of a possible DCC-sponsored safety program followed. Smith will obtain a quote for bike lighting in anticipation of the DCC offering them as part of a safe-cycling program.

Outgoing Vice President Brenda Taulbee had nothing new to report.

Advocacy Director Chuck Smith announced that the 2013 Ohio Bicycle Federation's "Bicycle Events Calendar," which reaches 25,000 cyclists across the state, will be available in March. The DCC will submit entries for major rides in December and a quarter-page color advertisement.

Bikeways Director Chris Brown discussed a *Dayton Daily News* article about the bikeway being developed in the Austin Boulevard area. There is controversy because the path is slated to be placed very close to the entry to a residence instead of on the opposite side of the road where there is more room.

Webmaster Harv Kiesel said he had posted

information on the DCC website about a Nov. 25 charity ride starting at Xenia Station to raise money for victims of sexual violence in the Congo. Kiesel told the board the DCC needs to replace the outdated software used to maintain the club website. He also announced that 2013 will be his last year as webmaster. He is working to institute online payment of membership dues. Once that is accomplished, he will concentrate on online payment for merchandise, major rides and donations.

Newsletter Kay Wert Minardi presented the cost of mailing paper newsletters to club members who may want them. Based on the DCC's expenses for its last three newsletters, she estimates that it would cost the club about \$28 a year to send paper newsletters by first-class mail to a DCC member. The board reiterated its support of the all-digital newsletter.

Wert Minardi said the next newsletter should be available in late December. The deadline for articles is Dec. 5, and the advertising deadline is Dec. 10.

Secretary Donna Powell had nothing to report.

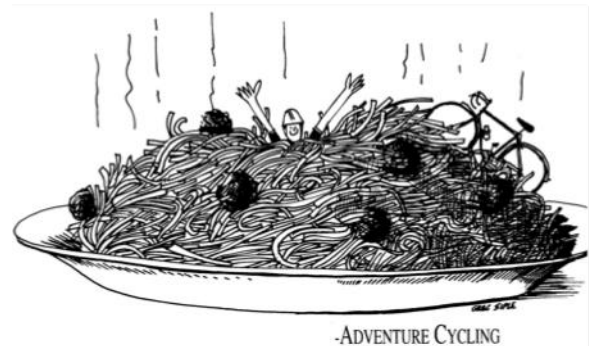
Social director Kathi Witte announced April 7 as the tentative date for the 2013 awards banquet, and she hopes to be able to hold it at Therapy Café again.

Since there was no further business, Smith moved to adjourn the meeting and Wert Minardi seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.

Life Enrichment Center Bike Shoppe needs help

The Life Enrichment Center Bike Shoppe, which supports transportation cycling and bike commuting on a massive scale in our area, needs the bicycle community's help.

The good folks at The Bike Shoppe take in unclaimed lost or stolen bicycles from area police and sheriff departments and fix them for use by the needy in our area. They also provide bike helmets and locks to the needy. Finally, the shop maintains the equipment used in Dayton's Yellow Bike bicycle-sharing program. Longtime DCC member Bob Pinnell is a regular Bike Shoppe volunteer.

The Life Enrichment Center is located behind the former Duriron headquarters building at 425 N. Findlay St. in East Dayton.

The Bike Shoppe was burglarized twice during November. Items were stolen during each break-in, but the losses each time were below the Life Enrichment Center's \$2,500 insurance policy deductible. The center is upgrading its security system to prevent a recurrence of these break-ins..

The Bike Shoppe had received some donations as of this writing, but the following stolen items still needed to be replaced:

- Bolt cutters
- 15 20-inch inner tubes
- 20 26-inch inner tubes
- 6-inch cut-off saw
- Craftsman cordless screwdriver set with bits
- LG flat-screen, 22-inch LCD monitor

Sticking out of the middle pocket on the back of the jersey is a graphic of a banana and a sheet of paper with the DCC wheel logo and the names of the club's invitational rides.
