From Interstate 70
 Take Interstate 75 south. Then follow directions below "From Interstate 75 north of Dayton".

From Interstate 75 north of Dayton
 Follow Interstate 75 to Exit 47. Turn left onto Dixie Hwy. Turn left onto Dryden Turn left at Main Street. Follow Main Street 1 mile. Turn left into Payne Recreation Center/Splash Moraine/Wax Park complex.

From Interstate 75 south of Dayton
 Follow 75 north to Exit 47 (Dixie Hwy). Turn left onto Dryden Rd. Turn left at Main Street. Follow Main Street 1 mile. Turn left into Payne Recreation Center/Splash Moraine/Wax Park complex.

Wax Park/Payne Recreation Center is located at 3800 Main St. in Moraine, Ohio.

Sign in for the Huffman Spring Classic in the shelter at Wax Park just behind the rec center.

Share a healthy day cycling the Miami Valley with the Dayton Cycling Club on our annual non-competitive, family-oriented Huffman Spring Classic. Along the way enjoy some great food, take in the blossoming spring scenery, make new friends, tell some cycling stories, explore our professionally marked routes and have some fun!

This year's routes range from flat to hilly, mostly on lightly traveled country roads. There will be 30-, 50-, and 62-mile (metric century) routes for your enjoyment. What challenges you? You will be riding beautiful roads. Some of the locations riders will pass through are Germantown, Gratis, Camden, Farmersville, and Brubaker Covered Bridge. (Not all routes pass through all locations.)

Your ride will include food/rest stops, SAG support, road markings (arrows) and a detailed map to keep you on track. At the end of the ride, join us for a picnic at Wax Park.

A new feature for this year is that we will publish the ride times for those who wish to participate. We will categorize by gender and age. But please note that this is for fun only, and is NOT intended to make the Huffman Classic a race. Because we are asking for riding times, not total times, there is no incentive to run stop signs or skip the rest stops. On the contrary, we insist riders obey all rules of the road, have fun and enjoy our SAG stops, and go slowly in an area that demands caution and safety.

If you want to participate, you should send your riding time (to the nearest one second from your computer or Garmin) to the ride director, Ken Mercurio, at kmerc@yaho.com.

Remember, we ride rain or shine.

Huffman Metric Century—62-Mile Route

The Huffman Metric Century route is our big spring tune-up for winter legs. 1976 feet of climbing. It is a journey with great riding on super quiet country lanes and over Brubaker Covered Bridge. (see Ride With GPS route on website)

50-Mile Route

The 50-mile route is fun (1525 ft of climbing). It's the reason you own and ride a bicycle. Cross the covered bridge, walk a trail at Germantown MetroPark and breathe in the fresh air. (Ride With GPS route is on the website.)

30-Mile Route

This route is perfect for beginning riders and for people looking for a morning-only activity. Only 781 feet of climbing. You will be passing through Germantown MetroPark and their Covered Bridge. (Ride w GPS route on website)
